ERASMUS+ PROGRAM APPLICATIONS FOR 2021-2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

Undergraduates with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 and currently in their minimum 3rd or maximum 5th registration semester (students in their 6th registration semester can apply for this year only) are eligible to submit their applications online through our web based program at <http://app.erasmus.bilkent.edu.tr>

After those students complete online form, they have to print-out their application forms, sign it and upload it into their online application along with their CV's and statement of purposes between 3 -22 March 2021 to complete their applications.

The deadline for the online application is 22 March 2021 at 17.00.

STARS database is used to calculate the students' ranking in a particular department. The ranking will be based on %50 CGPA and %50 language proficiency. The language proficiency level of each applicant will be calculated based on his/her score received in ENG 101 (%25) and ENG 102 (%25) courses. For students who choose Pass/Fail grades in their courses, the letter grades behind SE and UE will be used to calculate their CGPA points. Same method will be used for English proficiency points if ENG 101/102 courses were graded with SE/UE.

Children of veterans and martyrs will be given "+15" points. Students with disabilities and those under protective care, as per Law No. 2828, will be given "+10" points.

Those students who are applying for mobility to the country they hold the nationality of will be given "-10" points.

Qualified students' CGPAs will be checked by the Office of International Exchange Programs at the end of Spring 2021 and Fall 2021 to make sure that they are still qualified for the program.

If students are interested in going to a university that the language of instruction is different than English, they will also need to submit an official certificate proving their proficiency level in that language. The minimum level should be B2. Those, who do not have a certificate, will be allowed to take the proficiency exams on Italian, Spanish, German and French that will be organized by Foreign Languages Unit. Exams will be organized online. Written exams will be held on 15 March 2021 Monday, between 18.00-19:30 and online oral exams will be held on 17 March 2021, between 18:00-19:30. Students, who would like to take these exams, have to inform Office of International Students and Exchange Programs (OISEP) until 10 March 2021 by sending an e-mail to exchange@bilkent.edu.tr
