



APPLICATIONS FOR Student Exchange Program via Non-Erasmus Bilateral Exchange Agreements for 2023-2024

Bilkent has exchange agreements with several major universities in the world.

The Exchange Program gives students the opportunity to study abroad for semester during the 2023-2024 Academic Year. Students with a minimum CGPA of 3.00 and completed minimum 2nd or maximum 4rd semester at their departments are eligible to apply to the program. Students will be able to submit their applications online, through http://app.erasmus.bilkent.edu.tr/ and should upload the below mentioned enclosures to online application portal;

- a CV
- a statement of purpose
- signed application form
- a TOEFL score/ TOEFL registration document (if requested by partner universities)

Online application portal will be open from 10 April 2023 to 24 April 2023 at 17.00 and students can submit their applications under the "BEA-Bilateral Exchange Applications" menu.

University wide results will be announced to the students on 12 May 2023 at 17.00.

Exchange Coordinators could classify the applicants through their CGPA's and may conduct online interviews with the applicants

Please note that the qualified students should keep their CGPA at the minimum level of 3.00 until they leave for the exchange program.

Important note to the applicants; Some partner universities may prefer to defer the Fall semester nominations into Spring semester this year. Students who would like to choose Fall semester but cannot be nominated due to deadlines can be switched to Spring or upon coordinator approval, they may be placed to other slots for Fall. Students cannot switch their application semesters later to their graduation semester.
