- Nomination & Application Deadline: **31 May 2025!**
Please note that late nominations and applications will not be considered.
- Tuition Fees: Free for students from partner universities!
Students must cover their own travel, housing, and personal expenses.
- Nomination process: Only degree-seeking students can be nominated. To nominate students, please email us their name and email address. Please ensure that nominations are submitted by the deadline, as applications without a nomination cannot be considered.

Course Selection

Course spots are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. We strongly encourage students to apply as soon as possible to secure their spot. Students will be notified in June about their course placements.

Student can take as many courses as wish during the ICT Summer School if timings of the courses do not clash. Course requests with conflicting schedules will not be considered.
